Family of Parishes Holy Year Pilgrimage to Rome

This year is a Holy Year, or a Jubilee Year (held every 25 years) and Pope Francis has declared 2025 the Jubilee Year of Hope.

The Holy Father has said that this is an "**event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church.**" He wrote that it is to be "planned and celebrated with deep faith, lively hope and active charity".

Following discussions at the Parish Assembly and after exploring travel options, we are organising a Jubilee Pilgrimage to Rome for four days (three nights) from Monday Sept 1st to Thursday Sept 4th.

The pilgrimage will include return flights from Cork, B&B accommodation at a central hotel in Rome, visits to the principal sacred sites in Rome, attendance at a Papal Audience (subject to the Pope's itinerary), pilgrimage Masses and devotions along with time to visit various sites.

The pilgrimage will have limited numbers and a spiritual director. Cost is €1,220 pps. Deposit is €350. Further information and booking contact Karen at Barter's Travelnet, Cork (021) 4851700
